2/3 yd matching fabric for pillow back (cut to 16.25" x 24"

2/3 yd shape Pellon SF101 flex (cut to: 15.5" x 23.5")

16" pillow form.

Thread

Quilting thread (coordinates with pieced top

Open-toe foot

Free-motion foot

# Optional:

Water or air soluble fabric pen Quilter's ruler, Thread snips Rotary blade, sturdy pins or clips.
